ANNUAL REPORT

Excellence is an art won by training and habituation

Academic year 2021 to 2022 began on 5th April at St. Xavier's high school. Amoun The first wave of COVID-19 was over. High school children and teachers began the year enthusiastically while the primary and kindergarten children continued to take classes online. But unfortunately by April 16, our school like any other had to close down due to the second wave of COVID-19. Online classes resumed. Attendance in the primary section was 80% and high school was about 90%. In this scenario the first unit test was conducted online via Google forms from 5th July to 19th July 2021. The answer sheets were submitted in school on specified dates. This situation continued until August 21 2021. About the same time we had Father John King Bharath as our new principal. Offline classes began for high school while the primary section continued their online classes.

First Term examination was conducted offline for high school from 15th September to 30 September, while the primary children took the exams from home they wrote their answers in papers sealed by school office. About 10% high school children took their Exams online.

The principal had conducted a survey to gather children's feel for fear of exam at high school level and conducted a seminar for teachers on the same. Teachers set standard question papers and analysed them in detail under the expertise of the principal

Top scorers continued to show their excellence.

The second term saw primary children coming very cheerfully to school. The second unit test was conducted successfully from 25 November to 5 December. After that the kindergarten section too set their nimble feet in the portals of our school

Again we had to revert to online classes with the surge in the third wave of covid... from 30th December to 4th of February. It has been commonly observed by the faculty that the ability to follow instructions by children is not upto the mark, due to the covid pandemic.

Inspite of this students are now ready to appear for their annual examination which commences from 26th February which will be conducted offline for Kindergarten, Primary and High school students.
